How do I open and manage my account?	Each month the deposit can vary from £10 - £500 to still be eligible for the conditional bonus.	
	This account can be opened if: You are resident and tax resident in the UK. You pay in at least £10. The maximum you can open the account is £500. One account per member. How to open the account Fill out the online application through our portal. Pass an electronic identification check, if there is any issues with this we may request physical identification. Send us between £10 - £500 by bank transfer within 7 days of completing the application. Managing your account Each month the account must receive one payment between £10-£500 and also have no withdrawals in the year to be eligible for the Conditional Bonus. This account is managed online only. Please contact us if you need assistance from us.	
Can I withdraw money?	Yes, however if any withdrawals take place the conditional bonus will be lost. You can normally make a withdrawal on demand via Faster Payment, this will be through the transfer functionality within the online portal. All Faster Payments must be made to the nominated bank account linked to the account. Refer to our General Savings Terms and Conditions and the Framework Contract for Payment Services for more information on withdrawals.
